FLAVOR & COMMON USES

Tarragon has a delicate, aromatic flavor with notes of anise and sweetness, making it a classic herb for savory cooking.

1 FLAVOR PROFILE

- 1 Mild licorice or anise-like taste
- 2 Slightly sweet and aromatic
- 3 Delicate herbal freshness
- 4 Light peppery note
- 5 Best used to enhance rather than overpower dishes

2 COMMON USES

- 1 Chicken and fish dishes
- 2 Egg dishes like omelets and deviled eggs
- 3 Cream sauces and béarnaise sauce
- 4 Salad dressings and herb vinaigrettes
- 5 Vegetables, especially potatoes, carrots, and green beans
- 6 Infused vinegar, herbal butter, and marinades



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
